1. Recommendation on ordinance updates to Village Ordinance 7.085 All-Terrain Vehicles and All-Terrain Vehicle Routes: The committee discussed making changes to the hours of operation, head gear exemptions and age of operation. **Motion** Borner/Beissel to make these changes to be the same as the state and DNR. **Motion Amended** Borner/Beissel to strike the hours of operation and follow state statute. Unanimous.
2. Recommendation on ordinance updates to Village ordinance 7.086 Utility Terrain Vehicles and Routes: **MSC** Borner/Beissel to make changes to Section 7.086 similar to Section 7.085. **Unanimous.**
3. 223 E Main St. resident request for guard rail or structure to be installed at that location: The committee discussed this item and that it is not in the Village right-of-way. However, village officials are following up with the appropriate individuals to get more information.
