Animal & Fowl License Application

License Fee \$50

This license allows you to keep animals and/or fowl in compliance with the Village of Ellsworth Municipal Code (Section 9.12 & 11.09)

9.12 ANIMALS AND FOWL. No person having in his possession or under his control any animal or fowl shall allow the same to run at large within the Village. [Ord. 616 08/2011, Ord. 660 3/2017]

11.09 KEEPING OF ANIMALS AND FOWL. No person shall keep within the Village any animals or fowl, except domesticated pets, without permit issued by the Animal Warden/Humane Officer. In issuing a permit for animals or fowl, the Animal Warden/Humane Officer shall consider the number of such animals expected to be kept, the location, and the likelihood of a public or private nuisance being created. "Domesticated pets" include dogs, cats, mice, gerbils, hamsters, turtles, non-poisonous snakes and lizards. "Animals or fowl" refer to any exotic animals and animals associated with agriculture and farm husbandry including, but not limited to: cows, pigs, sheep, horses, goats, llamas, buffalo, ostriches, ducks, geese, chickens, doves. CHICKEN CONDITIONS: no more than 10 allowed (no roosters), no free roaming, wings must be clipped, favorable signed letters from adjoining property owners, must take reasonable measures to keep aesthetically pleasing with no odor/debris complaints and must be contained.
