I agree to pay ALL future Village of Ellsworth Water and Sewer Utility bills in full by the due date. I understand that bills unpaid by October 31st will be subject to a 10% penalty, and will be applied to the property tax rolls for the service address shown above pursuant to State Statute 66.0809(3). It is agreed that upon default of any installment, the entire balance will become due and service may be disconnected after notice of not less than 24 hours but not more than 48 hours prior to disconnection. Upon default nothing herein shall constitute a waiver of the rights on the part of the Utility to collect the unpaid balance or to prevent it from exercising its right to disconnect service on account of such delinquency. In the event service is disconnected, it shall be reconnected only upon payment of all past due charges and reconnection charges.

If you believe the terms of this agreement are unreasonable, DO NOT SIGN IT. You have the right to suggest a different payment agreement. If you and the Village of Ellsworth Water and Sewer Utility cannot agree on terms, you may ask the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin to review the disputed issues. If you sign this agreement, you agree that you owe the amount due under the agreement; signing this agreement does not affect your responsibility to pay for your current service. Allowing any bill for current service to become delinquent places you in default of this agreement.
